

## Cooperative Agreement Quality Metrics

In accordance with W. Va. Code section 16-29B-28(g)(1)(B), hospitals that are party to a cooperative agreement involving the combination of hospitals must disclose the performance of each hospital with respect to a representative sample of quality metrics selected annually by the WV Health Care Authority (Authority).
