- Complete second State Health Plan Annual Report.
- Work on updating relevant State Health Plan information needed for implementation activities.

### Fall 2001 Activities

- Retreat regarding Lead Agencies' implementation needs.
- Public distribution of the second State Health Plan Annual Report.
- Presentation of Lead Agency requests for funding and statutory changes to the Legislature by the Authority.
